The Newbury Spring Festival has been bringing live music from the world's leading artists to Newbury and its surrounding villages since 1978. In that time it has played host to artists such as City of Birmingham Symphony Orchestra, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, The Sixteen, Tenebrae, Alison Balsom and Anoushka Shankar. The Festival is widely renowned for its commitment to world class music and locally it also provides free workshops and performances for children.

The Festival is lucky to receive strong support from its patrons and audience, but we receive no core funding and are always looking to broaden our network of supporters. There are a number of ways to support the Festival and we hope you will join us.

### Sponsorship

Sponsorship of a concert or event starts at £1000. Benefits can be tailored to suit and include print and website acknowledgements, hospitality, and complimentary tickets and programmes. All sponsors enjoy priority booking and an invitation to our sponsors dinner. Grants from Charitable Trusts fund our education and community programme of workshops as well as concerts and are a vital part of the Festival's income.

### Individual Giving

Individual philanthropy is particularly important to us, since these funds are unrestricted, which enables us to apply the money where it is most needed. Moreover, if the donation is eligible for Gift Aid, we can reclaim a further 28% of the value.
